The Mozart year was off to a flying start with Christopher Hogwood conducting a highly-acclaimed new production of "La Clemenza da Tito" for the Australian Opera.... Harpsichordist Paul Dyer has just been awarded the Conservatorium Teacher Fellowship, allowing him advanced study in Europe with Andreas Staeher and Nikolaus Harnoncourt in the middle of the year. Meanwhile in Australia, his Brandenburg Orchestra receives rave reviews..... Michael Atherton's long-awaited book "Made + Played in Australia" was given a Powerhouse launching in November. Crammed with photographs, it reveals the true extent and diversity of musical instrument making in this country..... ABC-FM broadcast an enjoyable two-part series on Melbourne Harpsichord Makers in December. Alastair McAllister, Marc Nobel and Alan Todd were interviewed, and Elizabeth Anderson played examples on different instruments of the three makers..... The Melbourne Organ & Harpsichord Festival celebrates its 21st year with disappointingly little harpsichord this year. It seems Fortepiano must supplant Harpsichord in the Mozart year, or else a solo harpsichord is unable to sustain audience attention for more than ten minutes..... Fortepianist Geoffrey Lancaster has moved to Brisbane to accept a position at the Queensland Conservatorium. Unfortunately, our planned January North Coast tour under the Festival Arts Management banner didn't eventuate. Maybe later....

FOR HARPSICHORD OWNERS . . .

More from the Musical Instrument Insurance Maze. Any insurance is a gamble, of course, and over the years I have been caught up with brokers who initially bent over backwards only to become uncontactable spending all their time chasing new business instead of looking after their established clientele. However, it looks like a new policy underwritten by Australian Eagle will be very helpful to professional and amateur musicians alike. They have prepared brochure which is yours for the asking.

A good harpsichord requires surprising little in the way of maintenance to keep it in fine shape, but it amazes me on my travels around the continent how few instruments are delivering anywhere near their full potential. While I suspect that many instruments were probably never right when they were new (let alone now), often only some simple adjustment is needed after acclimatization and playing in. Once an instrument is in perfect working order, it is quite easy to keep it that way. You might need to learn a few skills like replacing a broken string or plectra, or perhaps fixing a sticky note in humid weather. We continue to recommend Ed Kottick's "Harpsichord Owner's Guide" for those who haven't a clue how to go about these things. This book is so useful, we give it away with every custom harpsichord order. Or you can use the coupon below and send \$60.

You don't have to own one of our instruments to buy the necessary maintenance materials like strings and plectra that we keep in stock. But please tell us what your instrument is, and be sure to order your strings by material and size in thousandths of an inch, or send a sample. Harpsichords and organs will never go metric. (Ever heard of a 2.44m stop?). Ask for our spare parts list.

New from Zuckermann. We are offering several new custom instruments in Australia for the first time, including the German Single and Concert Double. You might have already heard our New Italian Harpsichord in concerts in Sydney or Brisbane. The Italian Box Virginal has made way for a new 56-note brass-scaled Large Virginal design which will be available in kit form. The Fretted Clavichord is now made in American cherry.
