In Sydney, Luke Green and Nadia Piave took over direction of the Burwood Early Music Festival, held at St Paul's Anglican Church in mid-August. The Sacred Heart Early Music Festival has now been running in Melbourne for three years, and this year it saw some friendly competition from the Two Churches Festival of Early Music & Dance. Adelaide's Baroque Music Promotions continues to assist the International Barossa Music Festival and together with Ed Bolkovac's Brisbane Early Music Festival you can see it is almost impossible to escape the springtime musical flourish around the country...

Especially when you consider University of Western Australia continuing its tradition in early music education by hosting a Classical Orchestra Spring Academy in early October. Fortepianist Geoffrey Lancaster was Artistic Director leading a team of

top-name string and wind tutors...

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
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
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
